Principal's Report	<p>Motion to endorse the Principal's report Moved by: Trisha Jones Seconded by: Shireen Nakagami</p> <p>Principal has had a warm welcome to Windaroo Valley SHS and acknowledges Tracey's leadership. 2026 AIP – was shared in 2025 and it aligns to the DoE's Brighter Futures framework – includes 2 pillars – Educational Achievement and Belonging and Well-being. Lots of similarities to Equity and Excellence. Principal met with the new school supervisor and he has given feedback that needs to be actioned before Region endorses the plan. Feedback is to make bold 2 to 3 dot points from each section. 2026 School budget – due for finalisation end of February. Principal will finalise with the BSM. School was successful in getting a food grant - \$20,000. Grant is to provide breakfast, snacks for students. School will use this money rather than provision to provide these. 2026 total FTE – 1294.2 (increase in last year and includes the extra funding for the VETiS courses) – actual student numbers 1253. We will be staffed on 1294. Report includes the breakdown by year level. Primary visits have commenced this week for 2027 Year 7 enrolments. BYOD – 90% of students with laptops connected. Follow ups will start this week. Loan laptops available in the equity program. Focus on Digital Learning / technology in our staff PD (session next week). Facilities – Science floors and painted, Staffroom C toilets now have a clear thoroughfare next to them, Music block have had acoustic tiles added, new retaining wall next to GS3 block and synthetic grass, synthetic grass next to admin, replacement of ceiling fans across the school. Comment from students that the girl's canteen toilets is often out of soap and toilet paper. School calendar – full of opportunities for students to engage in other activities. To start the year Elevate Education seminars have started, Year 7s have had a good introduction to high school and enjoyed a half Star day in, academic celebration lunch (presented Hawker Harding scholarships). Next week – investiture, Rivers, Swimming carnival, school photos</p>
